**Useful Information for Confederate Headstone Dedication  
Glenwood Cemetery, Houston, Texas  
Saturday, March 27, 2010**

**Dress Code:** Casual. Wear comfortable shoes. Consider bringing umbrella and folding chair. Most of the walking route is shaded by large trees.

**Parking:** Carpooling is recommended, as there is limited parking in the cemetery. All traffic must enter via the Glenwood main gate, but most attendees will be asked to park in adjacent Washington Cemetery and walk into Glenwood. There will be guides to assist you. Please do not set car alarms, as the gunfire may set them off. Do exercise care when opening car doors, especially for those who are parking in Glenwood, as some car doors will not clear some of the brick curbs. Traffic guides are asked to be at the cemetery by **8:00 a.m.**

**Disabled Access:** For those who would have difficulty making the five-minute walk from Washington Cemetery on an unpaved surface, a few parking spaces have been reserved in Glenwood. If you need preferential parking please make your needs known in advance. Other than these few spaces, there will be no parking in the areas where the ceremony is taking place, so the roadway will be kept clear for the Route of March to the various graves. The walking route will cover about one-quarter mile round trip from the tent (much shorter than previous ceremonies). Most of the route, but not all, is on paved roads (see map).

**Assembly:** We will assemble at a tent located in front of the cemetery office. Everyone is asked to sign in and pick up a program. Pipers, color guard, honor guard, and photographers are asked to be at the cemetery by **8:30 a.m.** for orientation; descendants and members of UDC and SCV who have active parts in the program (readers and unveilers) are asked to be at the cemetery by **9:00 a.m.** The ceremony will begin at **10:00 a.m.** and is expected to last about two hours.

**Program:** The first part of the ceremony will be held at the tent. We will then proceed along the Route of March. At each site, one family member will read the veteran's biography; then one or two others will unveil the headstone. A microphone and speaker will be provided. For those veterans whose families have not been located or were unable to attend, members of SCV and UDC will do the honors. At the conclusion of all unveilings at each site, the Honor Guard will fire a musket volley for each man. The entourage will then proceed to the next site. The veils belong to Sherry Davis and will be collected at each site.

**Reception:** At the conclusion of the ceremony, everyone is invited to a reception hosted by Albert Sidney Johnston Camp 67 SCV at Trinity Lutheran Church, one mile east of the cemetery.

**RSVP:** Please let us know whether you are coming to the ceremony and whether you are coming to the reception, so we can prepare nametags and plan the reception. If responding by e-mail, please include "CSA - March 27" in the subject line.
